

Elections of European International Directors The new Rotation Scheme for Europe

This letter is intended to inform the Member Countries about the new Rotation Scheme for the position of International Director, and the reference to the **New Europa Forum Manual** (replacing RoP - *Europa Forum Rules of Procedures*). (here)

At the International Convention in Boston 2023, a resolution was approved to remove the minimum district requirements from the International Director qualifications. Removal of this requirement will permit qualified candidates from any district, including transitional and provisional districts, to contest for the office, provided all other qualifications are met. This change required a new Rotation Scheme for Europe, as the number of Lions Districts/Countries in Europe increased.

One of the tasks of the Long-Range Planning Committee Europe is:

"It shall also act as an advisory body to identify suitable recommended rotation which would enable fair opportunity to the members for European International Director positions."

"The LRPCE therefore has the responsibility of the suggested International Director candidate rotation list for Europe and when circumstances dictate, the elected voting members of LRPCE will meet (virtually) and adjust fairly with transparency, the rotation, to ensure that Europe has good, strong and appropriate candidates for European continuity. Any changes to the accepted list should first be submitted to the LRPCE via the Europa Forum Archivist & Advisor."

- Every year (even-numbered or odd-numbered) three (3) International Directors from clubs in Europe shall be elected for a term of two years.
- International Directors Candidates to be elected at the International Convention 2025, will be elected/endorsed at their District and MD Convention (no later than) spring 2024, and introduced at the Europa Forum 2024.
- If a member country would like to or shall change their ID term, the country needs to inform the LRPCE via the EF Archivist & Advisor, acting as Secretary of the LRPCE, as soon as possible.
- The current ID Rotation Scheme for Europe for the next 10 years is shown on the next page.
 It will be revised every three years, based on criteria, including the membership development.
