MINUTES

- 1. The meeting was called to order on time at 14:00
- 2. PID Phil NATHAN, President, Europa Forum 2014, welcomed all present and thanked them for their prompt attendance.
- 3. Credentials PCC Philip GOODIER, Forum General Secretary advised that all 31 registered voting delegates were present.
- 4. PCC Jeff Byers announced the Results of Lions European Musical Competition Thomas Kuti Award
 - (1) MD102 Switzerland/Lichtenstein
 - (2) MD111 Germany
 - (3) MD112, Belgium
- 5. Lion Dieter Van Hoye announced the results of the Lions European Young Ambassador Competition Award
 - (1) MD108 Italy
 - (2) MD105, British Isles & Ireland
 - (3) MD112, Belgium
- 6. **Voting on motions arising from workshops at the Europa Forum.** Forum President advised that these proposals required a simple majority to be carried:
 - a. To reconvene the 'working group' to review, study and make proposals: unanimous, 31 votes.
 - b. To ask the International Board to appoint a special envoy for the Reading Action

- c. Future Forum workshops are involving, motivating, relevant and challenging. more training on general topics and looking at the costs of attending the forum: unanimous, 31 votes
- d. After each Forum minutes, conclusions, are available from all seminars and workshop. Furthermore it is a must that free Wi-Fi is available in the forum area: unanimous, 31 votes
- e. In Augsburg and Sofia workshop and seminars focus on the future and not on the past: unanimous, 31 votes
- f. Responsibility for the Forum program is taken away from the host committee, to the responsibility of a group that will secure a red line from forum to forum. This group will work with the host committee. 22 Yes, 4 No, 5 Abstain. Carried.
- g. European Young Ambassador Committee to combine rules and procedures into one document.
 29 Yes, 1 No, 1 Abstain. Carried.

7. Voting on motions presented during First European Council:

- a. Motion EC1 D124 Romania, Archivist & Advisor. Forum President advised that this proposal required a 'two thirds' majority to be carried. **Voting 26 Yes, 5 No. Carried.**
- b. Motion EC2 MD105 British Isles & Ireland, Europa Forum 'Steering Committee'. Forum President advised that this proposal required a 'two thirds' majority to be carried. **Voting -** Unanimous, 31 yes. **Carried.**
- c. Motion EC3 D132 Macedonia, Bid to Host, Skopje, 2018. Forum President advised that this proposal required a simple majority to be carried. Voting 21 Yes, 3 No, 7 Abstain. Carried.
- d. Emergency Resolution MD111, Germany. Forum President advised that this proposal required a 'two thirds' majority to be carried. Voting 22 Yes, 1 No, 8 Abstain.
 Carried.

8. Any Other Business:

- (a) PID Phil NATHAN advised two changes to the previously published European International Director rotation.
- (b) PID Per Christensen updated Forum on the work being undertaken by the Board Elections Committee and that questions may be asked of Multiple Districts and Districts.
