# Lions Europa Forum Zagreb October 27-29, 2022 Final report

#### 1. General information

The Lions Europa Forum has been held, according to the Rules of Procedure, during the last week of October – Thursday to Saturday 27-29.

Entire program and most of the events have happened in the forum Hotel Westin Zagreb, only the musical competition was done in the nearby Musical Academy of Zagreb, and the Host Night in the beautiful Lauba Hall for People and Arts, where the host provided bus transport for all participants.

Already on Wednesday, October 26, a lot of meetings have taken place, e.g. EF Supervisory board, Long Range Planning Committee, various Multiple Districts meetings, and also the regional UNODC meeting with main topic Lions Quest.

All the events according to the Rules of Procedure have been made, like Opening and Closing ceremonies, Europa Council I and II meetings along with the discussion meeting, three social events, Get-Together party, Host Night and Gala dinner.

The participants used the opportunity of booking different excursions and sight seeing tours offered by the host.

Also, most of the participants arriving by plane, used the offered transportations from the airport to their hotels and back.

The Lions Europa Forum 2022 had a positive financial result.

### 6. Forum Program

The Forum Program had nearly 100 sessions, workshops and presentations from all areas of Lionism.

It was structured according to directions and recommendations from the Forum Rules of Procedures.

The program started already on Wednesday, October 26, with diverse business sessions like Forum Supervisory Board and LRPC meetings, meetings of GAT team, multiple districts and a remarkable Lions Quest regional meeting hosted by UNODC.

The main three Forum days, Thursday-Saturday, October 27-29, were filled with a lot of sessions.

All the executive officers had the opportunity to address the participant and share their thoughts.

A lot of Lions valuable activities of European Lions were presented in numerous sessions.

Youth Exchange MD and District officers had the opportunity to meet and present their youth camps.

Both youth competitions, LEMC Thomas Kuti and Young Ambassador competition Bert Mason were held successfully.

The three Europa Council meetings were held successfully and with valid conclusions and voting (separate report)

The program has comprised the opening and closing ceremonies.

One of the highlights was the Special Olympics tournament of three countries, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia and Slovenia, held in the Crystal Hall of the Forum hotel.

#### 7. LEMC Thomas Kuti

Celebrating the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary, the music competition Thomas Kuti and the final 6 concert has taken place at the Zagreb Music Academy, situated only few hundred meters from the Forum Hotel.

This year the "instrument" was the voice, and therefore the competitors age limit has been exceptionally increased, meaning the 26<sup>th</sup> birthday had to be in 2022 or later.

Europa Forum is a Non-political gathering of European Lions and global Lions friends. Respect for this intention is requested from all candidates seeking elected office. The use of posters, signs, banners and similar campaign material shall not be permitted.

As you now see, it is not allowed for candidates to use any form of marketing material, and yet unfortunately it has been done.

While we bring this to your attention at this time, and outline to you that this is not allowed in our Rules and Procedures, there are no consequences set out therein in the event of these Rules not being followed.";

PDG Drazen Melcic, Forum President, explains the rules for voting.

1st voting rule applies for voting "yes" (green card), "no" (red card) or "abstained" (white card).

2<sup>nd</sup> voting rule applies for voting for open Europa Forum Offices, Forum Accountant and Forum Archivist and Adviser. There will be a voting list with candidates' names to be voted upon, for each of

the two open positions.

Forum President PDG Drazen Melcic announced that the candidate of MD 103 France has withdrawn

his candidacy, so there will be only two candidates to be voted upon, from MD 108 Italy and from MD 111 Germany

As you now see, it is not allowed for candidates to use any form of marketing material, and yet unfortunately it has been done.

While we bring this to your attention at this time, and outline to you that this is not allowed in our Rules and Procedures, there are no consequences set out therein in the event of these Rules not being followed.";

Lions in eastern Europe claimed that average monthly incomes are about 700,00€, or less, so they can't attend. Asking the ID's to bring up this issue at the Board meeting, in order to achieve more solidary finance of the Europa Forum. If each of the European Lions contributed with 0,60€, it made possible for small countries to host the Forum."

1stVDG Kevin Harty, D 133 Ireland:

"Fabian has already answered the questions raised. Obviously in Germany a sizable member contribution of 618.000€ out of 800.000€ total budget. As new SD 133 Ireland, we don't have such resources. We have carefully examined the costs and incomes, but will try to reduce the costs and increase alternative incomes and reduce the delegate registration costs. Still, asking the delegates to support the resolution."

PID Andrea Stojkovski:

"Very low participation from central and east Europe at Europa Forums. Additionally, in some countries there is a visa application charge of 200,00€ for the EU. Tehrefore it's difficult to attend, to motivate for attendance and to get the visa.
