As I mentioned in our last LRPCE- meeting, there is a group of young Lions in Europe working on ideas to develop Lions membership.

They have formed a group they call Young Lions Task Force Europe - YLTFE.

They offer their time and talent to LRPCE and wish to be endorsed by LRPCE in a similar way as LTE, as a working group that reports to LRPCE.

This is similar to the Young Lions Task Force in USA/Canada, which is a part of the North American Membership Initiative - NAMI.

Some of the members of YLTFE have been involved in European events, like ELVS and New Voices, and the next event/session they will be in charge of as a group, will be at NSR, the "Nordic (Scandinavian) Council Virtual Event" January 16-17, 2021.
